Microphones and Sound Equipment

- Check Microphones and other Sound equipment before recording (cats have a way of changing settings)
 - Microphones plugged in
 - Sound board plugged in and settings are correct
 - Software is using the appropriate settings –
 - Make sure you are NOT using the the onboard microphone
 - Batteries for microphones and other devices charged

Other Equipment Housekeeping

- Do you have enough space on the drive to store the recording
- If using Skype are all settings correct (voice messaging...)
- Test the recording software. Is it actually recording or just monitoring? (I use Audacity)
- Other sources of noise mitigated? Cell phones on tables, laptops, * used as props....



Guest Housekeeping

- Have you confirmed your guest? time, place, source
- Warn them if you are a G Rated podcast....
- How do they want to be introduced
- Let them know how you conduct interviews and not to hang up when you close the formal inteview
- Guest Bumper/ ID for your show you can always ask
- Where can they be found on Social Media



Last but not least

Reboot if necessary (have you turned it off and back on?)



Some food for thought about your podcast

- Thoughts on how much you want to spend.....
 - Your brand Trademarking a phrase or name
 - Website
 - Hosting in multiple places
 - Give-away items
 - Cons, Film Festivals, other podcast specific events
 - Equipment



Sample Workflow

- Prepare script we use a loose script for talking points and general layout of show
 - Date, time, episode #, Title
 - Any sound effects, bumpers, id's, etc
 - Segment elements First segment talking points, birthday segment, Second segment
 - Follow-up items where to find you, any notes, or shout outs, etc
 - Wrap up



- Interview prep if doing interview
 - Pre email questions for background on guest it gives us info to ask questions
 - List of question ideas we have a list but like to keep our interviews conversational
 - Confirmed time, etc
 - Research any points of interest if necessary
- When guest joins, chit chat and set expectations (housekeeping)



- Check equipment See above
- Start recording Countdown, dead airspace, launch
- Make notations if necessary of times for editing purposes (Fbombs from guests, etc)
- Stop recording and immediately Save (I have multiple folders. One for Interviews aw and Edited, One for Show files, One for Episode files complete)
- Use dead airspace for Noise Removal
- Save again



- Use the Leveling function as necessary
- Save Again
- Edit as necessary from notes or other misc. edits
- Save again
- Export as chosen file (I use .mp3) adding any tags
- Load into iTunes for additional editing (adding artwork)
- FTP .mp3 to site
- Load .mp3 into video software



- Crunch to .mp4 for YouTube
- Create Show article (contains Show Notes, links to items discussed or guest sites, follow-up items)
- Load to YouTube with header from article
- Add link to Article/ Show Notes in YouTube description
- Schedule YouTube publication time
- Add YouTube link to Article
- Schedule for publication



- We use WordPress for our site and several plugins that can schedule the post and publish to multiple platforms (Twitter, Facebook, etc.)
- Pray that it all works
