

Below is our standard blurb we send for interviews. If you have the time, a few short answers will help us be better prepared.

We usually start with a little small talk to get sound adjusted etc. launch into the recording session and when we are ready to wrap up, Ben will ask “where can our listeners find out more about you, any social media, etc?” We generally like to keep the mood conversational rather than “interview-y”. Our goal is to give you the opportunity to tell our listeners about you and your projects so, we can talk as long or short as you wish. And if we go off on a tangent about something completely unrelated that is okay too.

Here are some generic points we might use to spur conversation but we are not limited to the items on the list.

1. Who are you and what do you do
2. How did you get into film making/ writing/ comics
3. Other projects associated with
4. Current project
5. Any specifics you want to share
6. Where can you be found
7. Do you have photos you wish to share of yourself and/or your work (for the article/ Show notes on our website)

Just a few items that facilitate a better recording session:

A Microphone plugged into a sound board of some kind and then into your computer (or a microphone plugged directly into your computer), if using Skype to Skype.

If using a telephone an external microphone is preferable to the internal.

A smaller room or somewhat confined space for the recording is suggested to limit the echo. Or, a piece of foam (not Styrofoam) or packing material on the other side of the microphone works well.

Be as close to the microphone as possible.
